

# Evolve Treatment Centers Remains Open: **Keeping Clients and Staff Safe During COVID-19**

Evolve is an essential health care facility that provides lifesaving mental health and substance abuse treatment for adolescents. Our programs have remained open 24/7 throughout the coronavirus outbreak (COVID-19). As California enters its first phases of re-opening, Evolve remains committed to offering our services while prioritizing the safety of our clients and employees.

We are taking exceptional, front-line measures to ensure the health and safety of our clients and staff, going above and beyond the regulations and infection-control guidelines from the CDC and the California Department of Public Health.

#### To that end, Evolve Treatment Centers is:

#### · Sanitizing each facility to strict hygiene standards

Maintenance crew provides disinfectant fogging to each facility and company cars biweekly using our advanced misting/fogging equipment. Our facilities are professionally cleaned routinely, with high-traffic surfaces sanitized every four hours. All staff members wear facemasks for the duration of their shifts. Clients and staff also receive intensive handwashing training.

#### Screening new admissions

Prior to admission into our RTCs, all new clients will be required to test negative for COVID-19. Additionally, we have specific protocols in place in regards to traveling to the facility. For more information on our updated admissions protocol, please see page 2.

#### · Conducting frequent health screenings

Nursing staff check clients' and employees' vital signs multiple times a day, staying vigilant for symptoms of fever, cough, sore throat, and shortness of breath. Should symptoms occur, the individual will be tested for COVID-19 immediately.

#### Limiting facility access to essential staff only

We have shifted psychiatry, family therapy, family visits, and certain experiential therapies (art therapy, music therapy, etc.) to HIPAA-compliant video-conferencing platforms. Additionally, we have initiated the use of grocery delivery services to minimize our chefs' visits to local stores.

#### · Requiring social distancing at all times

We conduct group therapy sessions in the largest room in the home. Seating is arranged so that social distancing regulations between clients and staff can be maintained at all times. Groups such as yoga, meditation, physical fitness and psychodrama will continue as usual, with social distancing guidelines maintained. We have resumed equine-assisted therapy, with clients wearing facemasks throughout each session.

#### · Virtual PHP/IOP Programs

All outpatient care (individual, group and family therapy, psychiatry, multifamily groups) can be conducted via telehealth. Our San Diego and San Jose Partial Hospitalization Programs have transitioned to a hybrid in-person/telehealth format.

Evolve is continuously monitoring this ever-changing situation and will continue to adopt governmental and public health policies and guidelines.



# Admissions Protocol During COVID-19 Pandemic

#### **Residential Programs**

Prior to admission into our RTCs, all new clients will be required to test negative for COVID-19.

#### **Air Travel Policy**

When traveling by plane, before booking a flight, Admissions must review the preferred airline's sanitation, face coverings, air filtration, and social distancing protocols.

We ask that families take a direct flight. Additionally, we encourage families to book the first flight of the day to avoid crowds.

To avoid the need to wait in crowded baggage claim areas, clients are asked to only bring carry-on luggage. Parents may ship additional belongings to the facility either before or after the client's arrival.

For transportation from the airport, to reduce risk of coronavirus exposure in taxis and Ubers, families may rent a car through one of Evolve's approved rental car providers. These providers ensure that each car undergoes a rigorous, multi-step disinfection and sealing process before being rented out to customers.

Should a family need to stay overnight on the way to our program, our admissions team must review the hotel's COVID-19 protocols. We ask that they not stay with any friends or family members on the way to the program, as this increases potential COVID-19 exposure.

The day of admission, parents/guardians are asked to escort their teen until the entry of the home, where a staff member will be waiting to greet them. RTC staff will wash and disinfect the client's clothing and belongings immediately.

## **Intensive Outpatient/Partial Hospitalization Programs**

We are beginning to admit community-based clients to our San Diego and San Jose PHP programs. These programs have transitioned to a hybrid in-person/telehealth format. Just as in our RTCs, all new clients will be required to test negative for COVID-19 prior to admission.
