EIDL (Economic Injury Disaster Loan)	<u>Through Dec 31, 2021.</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•EIDL loans are now capped at \$500,000.</li> <li>• If you already received an EIDL Loan, you may receive an email from the SBA if you wish to increase your loan.</li> <li>•If you received an EIDL grant in 2020 for less than \$10K you may be eligible to receive a larger amount.
